15 December

21 December

New church streams were started in Thailand, Myanmar and Southern Vietnam over the past few months. We pray for these new Hub-leaders who are implementing the new church planting methodologies which focuses on evangelism and

discipleship. We pray that these countries will be a shining beacon in Southeast Asia.

22 December

Harvesters Ministries is still new in the UK and people are not always open to us. We pray for many more church contacts and invites to share the wonderful work of Harvesters at various meetings.

23 December

Lord Jesus, we pray for the HLT's who voluntarily go out and train Hub-leaders all across the globe. We pray that You will strengthen them and keep them encouraged throughout their training trips.

24 December

We praise God for this amazing opportunity and pray that He will protect our team while they are visiting Kenya.

We pray for a blessed time during the training sessions where people will really be inspired by what Harvesters Ministries is doing.
