

Prayer Guide

15 May to 14 June 2019

Jeremiah 29:12 “Then you will call on Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.”

May 15 – India

India's national elections will end on May 19. Please continue to pray with us that the remainder of the elections will be peaceful. Pray that God will place the right people in parliament who will value and protect the Christian community in India.

May 16 – Cape Town, South Africa

Pray for individuals who will be attending and completing the Harvesters Licensed Trainer (HLT) Phase B training in Cape Town today. Pray that they will hear God's voice and avail themselves to do His work in any of the more than 60 countries where Harvesters is currently training pastors, making disciples and planting churches.

May 17 – Zanzibar, Tanzania

The North side of the Zanzibar island is closed to tourists and under strict Sharia law. One of our loyal pastors feels called to evangelise the Muslims in this area of the island and has already planted a church there. Pray that God will grant him strength and wisdom when he works in this dangerous area.

May 18 – Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Malawi

Two terrible tropical storms – Cyclones Idai and Kenneth – hit large parts of Mozambique as well as Zimbabwe, Malawi and Tanzania. Pray for the victims, loved ones of the victims and the families of the 19 Harvesters pastors who tragically lost their lives. Pray for this crucial time where those who do not know Jesus can be reached with the Gospel.

May 19 – Lubumbashi, Democratic Republic of the Congo

Pray for the Kick-Off that is taking place in Lubumbashi in the DRC today. The DRC has an extremely high poverty rate as a result of the decades of war and violence. Pray that the pastors who will attend the training will reach the lost despite the challenges they might face themselves.

May 20 – Sri Lanka

On Resurrection Sunday a terrible act of terrorism stole more than 300 lives in Sri Lanka. Many of those who passed away were Christians. Numerous bombs exploded – churches and hotels were among the targets. Today we pray for the loved ones of the victims. We pray that God will comfort them during this time of grief. We pray that those who were responsible for the bombings will have a personal encounter with our Lord Jesus Christ.

May 21 – Argentina

Today we pray for the Harvesters pastors who are evangelising the lost and making disciples in Argentina. More than a third of the population live in poverty and only 20% of Christians in Argentina live out their faith. We pray that the unreached people in Argentina will be reached with the Gospel.

May 22 – Chad

Pray with us for the Harvesters pastors in Chad. Christians in this Muslim-majority nation are facing increasing levels of persecution from local officials and violence from the Islamist militant group Boko Haram and militant herdsmen. Pray that our pastors will persevere and continue to evangelise the lost in Chad.

May 23 – Kitwe, Zambia

Pray for the Phase A training that is taking place in Kitwe, Zambia today. Pray for travel mercies for our training team as well as the safety of the pastors who will be attending the training. Pray that they will go out and enlarge God's Kingdom in Zambia.

May 24 – Amazon, Brazil

With more than 4000 unreached villages on the banks of the Amazon river our work is still far from done in the Amazon. Pray for our pastors who are working in these villages. Pray that God will strengthen them as they go out and share the Gospel. Pray that the Amazonian people will stop with their tribal practices and turn to Christ.

May 25 – Sierra Leone

This majority Muslim country is challenging to work in. More than 77% of the population are Muslim and do not know Jesus Christ. Pray for our pastors as they go out evangelise the lost, make disciples and plant churches in this Muslim country.

May 26 – Angola

Recently hundreds of Harvesters churches were closed down by the Angolan government. This is not stopping our pastors. They are planting new churches and making disciples. Praise the Lord for these dedicated pastors and their willingness to go out and share the Gospel.

May 27 – Meru, Kenya

Pray for the Kick-Off that is taking place today with 400 pastors in Meru, Kenya. Pray for our training team's safety, as well as the safety of the pastors who will be attending the training. Pray that these pastors will go out and evangelise the lost in Kenya. Pray that they will truly enlarge God's Kingdom in Kenya.

May 28 – India

Today we pray for the “Dark villages” all across India. There are more than 400 000 villages in India with no

church and no Christian witness. In India more than 22 000 die daily without knowing Jesus Christ. These people are lost forever and will not spend eternity in heaven. Pray that our pastors in India will evangelise the lost in these “dark villages”.

May 29 – Mali

Recently gun men raided Fulani villages in Mali and killed 134 people, including women and children. It is extremely difficult to evangelise the lost in this Muslim country. Pray that God will strengthen our pastors as they go out and share the Gospel. Pray that they will stand strong in the face of persecution.

May 30 – Johannesburg, South Africa

Pray for the HLT Phase B training that is taking place in Johannesburg, South Africa today. Pray that they will be inspired and motivated to take up Jesus' Great Commission and go out to all the nations to make disciples. There are still more than 5 billion people across the globe who do not know Jesus.

May 31 – Rwanda

200 Kinyarwanda Bibles will be handed out in Rwanda today during the Graduation Ceremony. These Bibles will be handed out to student pastors who do not have a Bible of their own. Pray that these student pastors will reach the unreached in Rwanda with the Word of God.

June 1 – Vietnam

Our pastors recently completed Phase A and B training in Vietnam. They are passionate about sharing the Gospel, making disciples and planting churches. We pray for our pastors in Vietnam as they face persecution from their own government and from other religion groups.

June 2 – Zanzibar, Tanzania

Pray for the leadership meetings that will be taking place over the next few days in Zanzibar, Tanzania. More than 99% of this island's population follow the Islam religion. The island of Zanzibar is a hotbed for Islamic radicalism. Pray that these unreached people will be reached with the Gospel.

June 3 – Johannesburg, South Africa

Pray for the Harvesters Licensed Manual training that will be taking place in Johannesburg, South Africa today. Pray that these newly trained HLT's will hear God's voice and go where He wants to use them for His honour.

June 4 – Johannesburg, South Africa

Pray for the HLT Phase A training that is taking place today in Johannesburg, South Africa. We pray for our training staff who are travelling far. We pray that they will experience God's blessings in their lives. We also pray that the newly trained HLT's will each assist with the training in one of the Harvesters church streams across the globe.

June 5 – Philippines

We praise God for recently opening the door for Harvesters to plant churches and train pastors in the Philippines. Pray for the families of the victims of the earthquake that recently hit the Philippines. Pray that our pastors will reach those who do not know Jesus and share the Gospel with them.

June 6 – Chiang Rai, Thailand

Pray for the Phase A training that will be taking place today in Chiang Rai, Thailand. Thailand is in dire need of the Gospel as more than 95% of the population are Buddhist. Pray that the Harvesters pastors will reach the unreached in the villages where they evangelise the lost.

June 7 – Johannesburg, South Africa

Pray for the HLT Phase D training that is taking place in Johannesburg, South Africa. Harvesters truly values all our HLT's. They are our hands and feet in the field and we are grateful for these loyal servants of God. We pray that they will stay motivated as they go out and train pastors in the countries where Harvesters is currently working.

June 8 – Mongolia

We praise God for opening the door to work in Mongolia. We are grateful for the pastors who are eager to share the Gospel and plant churches in this Buddhist country. We pray that Mongolia will turn to Christ as they hear the Truth.

June 9 – Yangon, Myanmar

Pray for the safety of the pastors who will be attending the Phase A training today in Yangon, Myanmar. Most Christians in Myanmar get stuck in the cycle of poverty due to ethnic and religious discrimination. Pray that these pastors will go out and evangelise the lost even though they may face persecution for sharing the Truth.

June 10 – Lesotho

Our church streams in Lesotho are booming. Praise God for our loyal pastors who are planting churches in Maseru, Semonkong and Maputsoe in this mountainous kingdom. We trust that they will be a shining beacon of hope in Lesotho.

June 11 – Togo

Praise God for the amazing work that our pastors are doing in Togo. The harvest in Togo is plenty but the workers are few. Our pastors have planted 127 churches in Togo and they are continuing their hard work. Pray that God will continue to strengthen these pastors to continue with the great work that they are doing.

June 12 – Colombia

Our pastors in Colombia are facing many challenges as they go out and evangelise the unreached in their country. Pray that God's Kingdom in Colombia will enlarge and that Colombia will be saturated with churches.

June 13 – Bangladesh

We trust that God will open the door in this Muslim country where Christians face daily persecution. We pray that churches will be planted all across Bangladesh and that God will provide the right people to evangelise the lost in this nation.

June 14 – Egypt

We praise God for opening the door in Egypt. We will be returning to train the 100 pastors who have signed up for the Harvesters program. We trust that they will plant thousands of churches in Egypt and lead the lost to Christ. 🙏
