

# Prayer Guide

15 September to 14 October 2019

John 6:44 "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day."

## 15 September – Egypt

Harvesters recently trained more than 100 pastors in this North African country. This is a very sensitive area and extremely dangerous for Christians. Pray for our pastors' and their congregations' safety as they go out and evangelise the lost in this Islamic country.

## 16 September – India

A terrible flood recently hit India. The death toll for the floods have reached 244 and more than 1,2 million people were evacuated from their homes. Pray that our newly trained pastors will reach out to the hopeless and share the message of hope from the Gospel.

## 17 September – Cape Town, South Africa

Pray for the Phase B HLT (Harvesters Licensed Trainer) training that is taking place in the Mother City today. We trust that the Lord will show these newly trained HLT's where He wants to use them for His glory.

## 18 September – Chididi, Malawi

Recently a team from Harvesters took Bibles to the hill side and very remote area in Chididi, Malawi. Praise the Lord for each and every donor who made this possible. Pray with us that these Bibles will change communities and lead the lost to Jesus.

## 19 September – Ondjiva, Angola

We had the opportunity to train more than 100 pastors recently and start an entire new church stream in Ondjiva. Praise God for this amazing opportunity to plant churches in a country where the government thought that they could stop the Gospel. No one can stop Jesus Christ!

## 20 September – Uganda

Our Harvesters country leaders in Uganda are focusing on the refugee camps in northern Uganda and working among the Sudanese refugees. These Sudanese refugees are on fire for

Jesus and really captured the Harvesters vision. Pray with us that they will plant churches across the border in Sudan.

## 21 September – Zimbabwe

Violent protests took place in Harare and Bulawayo recently. Pray that peace will be restored to this beautiful nation and that our pastors will share the Gospel with the lost souls in Zimbabwe.

## 22 September – Mombasa, Kenya

Pray that the door will open for Harvesters to work in this predominantly Muslim area. There are many pastors who are very eager to start with the church planting process in this Kenyan county. We are trusting God that the necessary funds will be raised to start training here.

## 23 September – Myanmar

Pray for the more than 730 000 Rohingya refugees who fled Myanmar two years ago. Ask the Lord to grant them wisdom as their country has opened its doors to them and promised the safe return of 3 000 refugees. Pray that our pastors will share the love of Jesus with these refugees and other non-believers.

## 24 September – Malawi

Sadly, one of our Malawian country leaders recently had a stroke. Join us in prayer and trust the Lord to heal him. Pray that he will be able to continue his great work and that his legacy and impact will not be lost.

## 25 September – West Papua, Indonesia

There were many violent protests in this beautiful country recently. Ask the Lord to restore peace to this Pacific nation and that our Harvesters pastors will reach the lost with the Gospel. Pray that new believers will become disciples.

## 26 September – Benguela, Angola

Pray that the 50 pastors who recently received their training with Harvesters will go out and saturate their communities with churches. Praise the Lord for this incredible opportunity to win souls for His Kingdom in Angola.

## 27 September – Malaysia

Only 9% of the Malaysian population are Christian. Pray that our work here will continue to grow to reach the lost in this precious country. Pray that

non-believers in Malaysia will hear the Truth and that the Truth will set them free.

### **28 September – Venezuela**

There is a massive crisis in the country. Millions of people have left the country recently. Pray that hope will be restored to this beautiful country. Ask the Lord to strengthen the pastors who are winning souls during this crisis.

### **29 September – Mali**

The violence between the Fulani and Dogon ethnic groups is getting out of hand and no one knows when it will end. Our work here is far from done. Pray that the Holy Spirit will stir up a great desire for the non-believers in Mali to turn to Christ.

### **30 September – Chad**

A state of emergency has been declared in eastern Chad after more than 50 people were murdered as part of an ethnic killing spree. Pray that our Harvesters pastors will share the love of Jesus with these lost souls. Someone who knows Jesus will not take someone else's life.

### **1 October – Port Elizabeth, South Africa**

We praise the Lord for this special group of HLT's who will receive their Phase B training today. Pray with us that these newly trained HLT's will go out with new vigour and work in one of the more than 60 countries where Harvesters is currently training pastors.

### **2 October – Nampula, Mozambique**

Praise the Lord for the Phase B training that is taking place today. More than 100 pastors will receive training in this predominantly Muslim area today. It is a very sensitive area to plant churches in. This is the most densely populated area in Mozambique and we have a huge opportunity to plant churches here. Pray that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ will be glorified in this region.

### **3 October – Port Elizabeth, South Africa**

A group of HLT's are receiving their Phase E training today. Praise the Lord for this opportunity to equip individuals with training in evangelism and discipleship. Pray with us that they will take up the calling that God has placed on their lives.

### **4 October – Colombia**

Colombia is still experiencing a massive drug cultivation and manufacturing problem. Pray that our pastors will reach the unreached and share the wonderful news of the Gospel with them.

### **5 October – Ethiopia**

Ethiopia is the most strategic country in the Horn of Africa for us to work in. The group of pastors who we are training are really on fire for Jesus. Pray with us that they will continue to do their wonderful work and plant churches in their communities.

### **6 October – Zanzibar, Tanzania**

This tropical little island desperately needs the Gospel. Radical Islamic groups are aiming to

establish an Islamic state which includes the whole island and a large part of the mainland. Pray that our pastors will reach these radical Muslims and share the Truth with them.

### **7 October – Senegal**

Only 4% of the Senegalese population are followers of Christ. We need your urgent and fervent prayers to change this precious country. Pray that the Islamic stronghold on this country will come to an end and that these lost souls will experience the love of Jesus.

### **8 October – Durban, South Africa**

Praise the Lord for this wonderful opportunity to train HLT's in this beautiful, coastal city for the very first time. These HLT's will complete their Phase A training. Ask the Lord to inspire them to take up their calling and make disciples for our Lord Jesus Christ.

### **9 October – China**

You might have heard that the fastest growing church movement in the world is currently happening in China. What you might not know, is that our brothers and sisters in China face severe persecution for their faith. Pray that the Harvesters pastors in China will be strengthened by our Lord Jesus Christ to reach the lost in this nation.

### **10 October – Somalia**

This country is one of the most dangerous places for a Christian to live in. Harvesters recently trained pastors in Ethiopia who are starting church networks in Somalia. Pray that they will go out and evangelise the lost in Somalia.

### **11 October – Argentina**

This colourful South American country is only 9% evangelical Christian. The country has a dire need for the Church to grow and the true Gospel to be shared. Pray with us that the Harvesters church networks in Argentina will grow.

### **12 October – Cambodia**

With more than 97% of the population being Buddhists this tropical country needs our constant prayers. Continue to pray for our Harvesters pastors – ask the Lord to grant them the wisdom and strength to reach the lost in their country.

### **13 October – Sri Lanka**

We have our work cut out for us in this Asian country where there are only 1,3% evangelical Christians. Ask God to truly open the door for Harvesters to plant churches in this nation and reach the lost with the Gospel.

### **14 October – Japan**

The Japanese Christian population is among the smallest in the world. Less than 1% of the Japanese population claim to be Christians. Pray that our brothers and sisters will share the love of Jesus and the true Gospel with non-believers in Japan. 🙏
