15 February to 14 March 2020

“I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world” – John 16:33.

15 February – Peru

One of our teams recently trained pastors in this South American nation. This group of pastors is excited and passionate about church planting and reaching lost souls with the Gospel. Please keep them in your prayers as they go out, share the Gospel and plant churches in unreached communities.

16 February – Myanmar

Pastors in Myanmar face terrible persecution. Please pray for the Phase A training that is taking place there today. Pray for the safety of our team and the safety of the pastors who are attending the training. Keep them in your prayers as they share the Gospel in this hostile nation.

17 February – India

Pray for our team who is currently travelling through India and training pastors from eight different church streams. Ask the Lord to protect our team, as well as the pastors who are attending the training. Intercede for the training that is taking place and trust the Lord that all our training sessions in India will be successful.

18 February – Krugersdorp, South Africa

A group of Harvesters Licensed Trainers (HLT's) will be receiving its Phase A HLT training today. All of the HLT's that receive training have the option to become volunteers with Harvesters and work in any of the 63 countries where the ministry is currently working. Pray that God will show them where He wants to use them.

19 February – Thailand

The majority of pastors in Thailand need to work during the day and travel to neighbouring villages at night to share the Gospel – either by foot or by bicycle. Keep these pastors in your prayers. Ask the Lord to keep them safe as they go out and build His Kingdom.

20 February – Cote d'Ivoire

Please keep the pastors in Ivory Coast in your prayers. They face many struggles and still persevere

in their church planting efforts. These pastors have one desire – to build God's Kingdom.

21 February – Australia

Please keep this nation in your prayers. They just faced a terrible tragedy where bushfires destroyed millions of hectares of their country. Ask the Lord to bless this country and to comfort those who were affected by these fires.

22 February – Bethal, Mpumalanga

The Regional Director for South Africa recently started a training program at a prison in Bethal. There were representatives from six different prisons. Praise the Lord with us for this wonderful opportunity. Please pray that this training program will be successful and that the prisoners will have the opportunity to come to Christ.

23 February – Lubumbashi, Democratic Republic of the Congo

One of our teams is presenting Phase A training in Lubumbashi. Please keep the team and the pastors in your prayers as they implement what they learn from this training.

24 February – India

Pray that our team will be invisible to the enemy and that they will not draw attention where they are doing training. Please pray for the safety of the team and the pastors who are attending the training.

25 February – Rwanda

One of our teams recently had the opportunity to deliver 250 Bibles to pastors in Rwanda. This group of pastors was rejoicing to receive their very own Bibles. Pray that the Word of God will not only enter villages but that communities will be changed by the Truth.

26 February – Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of the Congo

There is a Kick-Off taking place in Kinshasa today. Please pray for wisdom for the team that is training the pastors. Pray that these pastors will always find their motivation in the Lord and that they will never rely on their own strength and understanding.

27 February – Philippines

Pastors in the Philippines face many challenges and many of them live in poverty. Pray for them as they go out and share the Gospel despite the challenges

they face. Ask the Lord to open many more doors for these pastors to reach the lost in the Philippines.

28 February – Amazon

The pastors in the Amazon recently received boxes filled with Bibles. Some of these pastors travelled for days on end to reach the village where the Bibles were handed out. Praise the Lord for their commitment. There are more than 10 000 villages with no access to a church. Pray that this will soon change and that God will continue to open the doors for the ministry to reach unreached communities.

29 February – Ondjiva, Angola

One of our teams is presenting a Refresher and Phase A training in Ondjiva today. Pray that this will be a truly blessed event. Ask the Lord to guide the team and pray that these pastors will make an impact in their communities.

1 March – India

Pray for the team's health. Ask the Lord to protect them from all illnesses, pests and physical attacks during their time in India. Pray that they will be able to complete their training in India without any physical challenges.

2 March – Port Elizabeth, South Africa

The Harvesters training team is currently presenting Phase B training to a group of HLT's. This group of HLT's can volunteer to train pastors in any of the 63 countries where Harvesters is currently working. Pray that they will be led by the Holy Spirit when they decide where to volunteer.

3 March – Benguela, Angola

A group of pastors is currently completing its Phase A training. Please keep this group in your prayers. They work in many rural areas and face daily challenges. The Angolan government has closed down many churches over the last few years. Pray that these pastors will persevere amidst the persecution that they face.

4 March – Luanda, Angola

Phase B training is currently being presented in Luanda, the capital of Angola. Ask the Lord to guide our team and to grant them the necessary wisdom to train this group of pastors successfully.

5 March – Port Elizabeth, South Africa

A group of volunteers are completing their Phase E HLT training. Pray that this group of volunteers will truly hear God's voice to go out and build His Kingdom. God can use anyone to build His Kingdom, and He equips those whom He has called.

6 March – Luanda, Angola

Today is a special day in Luanda! One of the groups of pastors is completing its Phase F training and graduating from the Harvesters program. Pray that this will be a special occasion and that the graduating pastors will realise their worth in Christ.

7 March – Mongolia

Pastors in Mongolia face unique challenges with the nomadic lifestyle of the population. It is difficult to reach communities. Despite these challenges this group of pastors has already planted 40 churches. Praise the Lord for their dedication!

8 March – India

The northern parts of India are really opening up for the work of Harvesters. Trust the Lord with us for favour and open doors to the right opportunities. Christians in India face heart-breaking persecution. Please pray that God will strengthen them continuously as they go out and share the Gospel in this hostile country.

9 March – Durban, South Africa

Please keep our training team in your prayers today. They are currently training a group of HLT's in Durban. This group of HLT's will be completing its Phase B training. Pray that this training session will be truly blessed and successful.

10 March – Mamelodi, South Africa

A group of volunteers recently trained pastors in this poverty stricken area. Pray that these pastors will stay courageous as they face the powers of darkness in their community. A person cannot change another person, but Jesus Christ can change someone's heart. Pray that people's hearts will be touched by Jesus.

11 March – Beira, Mozambique

It has been one year since the Cyclone Idai spread havoc and destruction in this beautiful nation. Please keep this precious nation in your prayers today. They are still rebuilding their lives after this terrible tragedy.

12 March – Yaounde, Cameroon

One of our teams is currently in Cameroon. A group of pastors is completing its Phase A training and getting ready to evangelise the lost in their communities. Please keep these pastors in your prayers as they share the Gospel and start planting churches.

13 March – Panama

There are more than 600 newly planted churches in Panama. Despite the high crime rate in this nation, people are coming to Christ. Pray that even more churches will be planted in Panama and that many more people will get saved from their sinful ways.
