### Madrid - Reignited to Make Disciples

arvesters' Disciple Makers training recently made a significant impact in Madrid, Spain, inspiring participants to rediscover our true mission as Christians: fulfilling the Great Commission. These dedicated believers have been reignited with a passion to make disciples across Spain.

Antonio Amigo and his church have had their vision renewed to focus on the Great Commission. Despite a history of multiplication and church-planting, an exaggerated focus on their current building and subsequent debts had "dimmed the vision, the desire to grow."

But now, Amigo's vision has been "transformed." He and other participants were reminded that a church can be started anywhere – unconstrained by budgets or buildings.

Pastor Luigi Ramirez also experienced first-hand that "you can start a church wherever... You can be church wherever. [You don't need] a rigid structure or financial administration to start a church."


Luigi and his wife began their ministry in an unconventional setting, sharing the Gospel over an ice cream at Burger King. They called it the "Salvation Ice Cream." By God's grace their ministry has grown, and they have planted three churches – one of them still in Burger King. Harvesters' Disciple Makers training will enable the Ramirezes to grow their ministry by discipling new believers.

Disciple Makers focuses on the fundamentals of sharing the Gospel, multiplication and discipleship. According to participant Josue Avila, these tools will unite his church with a "singular vision: to lead people to recognise Jesus as their Lord and Saviour"

By reigniting the passion for evangelism and discipleship, Disciple Makers is opening new pathways for spreading the Gospel throughout Madrid and beyond.







#### **A Blind Man's Vision**

In the rural expanse along the Zambezi River, we encountered a man whose testimony left us in awe. Pastor Paul Kamboi is blind, but the Lord who transcends physical limitations is using him in a mighty way.

Though his eyes may not perceive the world around him, Pastor Paul's spiritual vision knows no bounds. "I am able to see," he declares, his voice resonating with conviction and his face lit with a bright smile. "It's only the physical body that is blind, spiritually I am able to see."



In 1980, Paul received a profound calling from God to undertake His work. Despite his lack of formal education, Pastor Paul accepted the call and has been outworking it ever since. Today, his legacy spans over two decades and 20 churches planted—a testament to his joyful willingness and the extraordinary power of God.

Recently, Pastor Paul embarked on a new chapter of his journey with Harvesters Ministries. At the recent Kick Off event in Lukulu, Zambia, he eagerly embraced the opportunity to expand his ministry through pastoral and church-planting training.
